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## Is Your Worship E.P.I.C.?

*10 Practical Ways to Better **Engage People In Christ** During Worship Sets.*

- 1) **BE A** \_\_\_\_\_ **GIVER-** 1 John 2:6, 1 Cor 11:1, 2 Thess 3:9. Your congregation will not go to where their leader is not willing to go. You have to MODEL WORSHIP.
- 2) **TEACH YOUR** \_\_\_\_\_ **TO BE** \_\_\_\_\_ **GIVERS-** Matthew 28:19-20. Every person on the platform should be a permission giver and a worship leader.
- 3) \_\_\_\_\_ **PEOPLE EVERY CHANCE YOU GET-** Psalm 119:15, Phil 4:8. Since worship is so important, we must recognize the importance of our calling. When we see how much time we've been given to lead people in worship, we must always ask this question: In the time that I've been given, how can I lead people so deeply, so richly, and so authentically into the presence of Jesus?
- 4) **LEAD WITH** \_\_\_\_\_ - Mark 11:23, Matthew 28:18-20. You're not just the singer, the musician, the music director, etc. You are the LEADER! Come to my workshop tomorrow and we will talk more about what it means to lead with authority.
- 5) **SET THE ROOM** \_\_\_\_\_ - Psalm 150. What is the vibe of your room?

- 6) **INVITE PEOPLE TO \_\_\_\_\_ AND \_\_\_\_\_** - I Chron 16:9, Psalm 95:6. Give people space to focus in on Jesus and make Him the priority and focus of their worship. Invite them to participate by clapping, lifting hands, bowing, etc. REMEMBER, you can't always look at an action and assume a motive.
- 7) **SHUT UP AND \_\_\_\_\_** - Psalm 40:3, Psalm 49:4. Unless you feel like it absolutely enhances the experience or gives context to a song, don't talk in between songs.
- 8) **ELIMINATE \_\_\_\_\_** - Psalm 132:7, I Peter 2:9. Avoid things that could become a distraction..
- 9) **GIVE PEOPLE TIME TO \_\_\_\_\_** - John 4:23, Matt 2:9-11, I Corinthian 11:23-26. Use music, communion, offering, prayer, and specific responses as time of response.
- 10) **MAKE IT \_\_\_\_\_ INTELLIGIBLE** - Acts 2:13-14, Luke 24:45. This simply means that someone who doesn't have experience with God, the Bible or church can still understand what is going on.
